Rules and Proper Procedures for Putting Out the Trash

- ★ Please put the trash out by 8:30 a.m. only on the designated collection days, in a way that
- does not obstruct traffic. ★ Please separate types of trash and recyclables at home before putting out the trash.
- ★ Trash that is put out in anything other than the town's designated bags (such as in black plastic bags, etc.) will not be collected.
- ★ Bags containing a mixture of combustible trash, incombustible trash, plastics, and recyclables will not be collected.
- ★ The collection days may be changed in some cases, so please keep an eye on public
- ★ To avoid creating a nuisance for your neighbors, please put out the trash only on the designated collection days and only in the prescribed manner.






