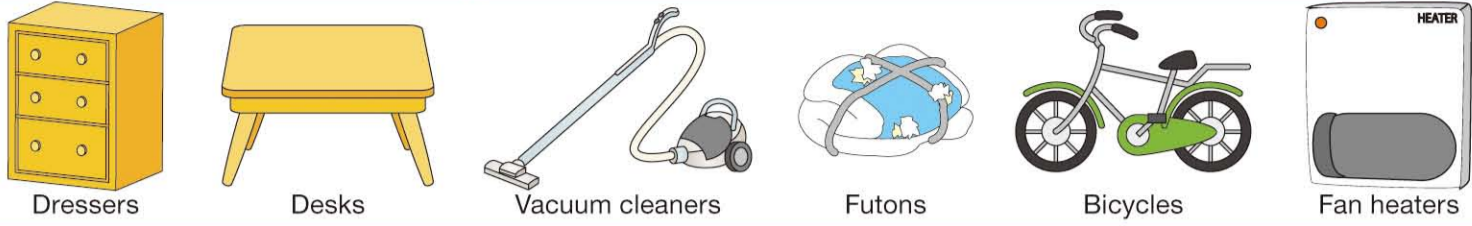


Large refuse items (picked up at one's residence; collection fee charged)

- Fee: 500 yen per item; maximum of 5 items
 - Collection requests: Go to the Industrial Environment Section at Oharu-cho Town Hall. (Telephone requests are not accepted.)
 - Collection request hours: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on days when Oharu-cho Town Hall is open (Requests are not accepted on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, and during the New Year holiday period.)
 - Collection request deadline: Collection requests must be made at least one week prior to the collection day (Thursday) for the neighborhood. (Please see the table below for the collection day for your neighborhood.)
 - Collection location: In front of the entrance to the residence, in the parking space or in front of the garage for the residence, etc. (picked up at one's residence)
- ※Please be aware that if a confirmed collection request is canceled, the collection fee cannot be refunded.

Items that cannot fit inside a designated bag with its mouth bound closed (at least 50 centimeters long and shorter than 2 meters), or items that cannot be carried in one hand



Examples of Large Refuse Items

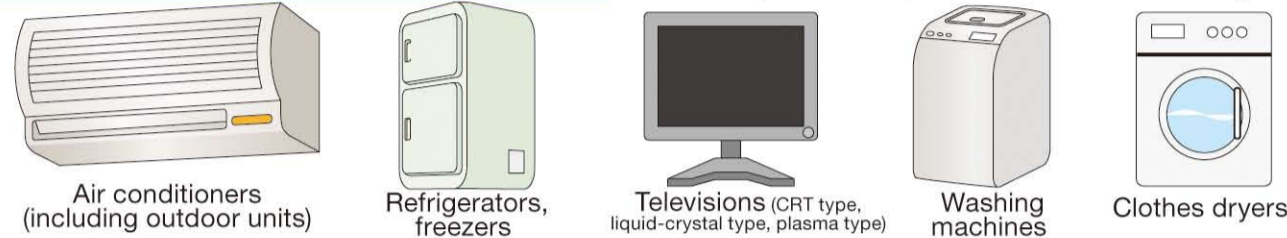
Furniture, bedding, etc.	Desks, chairs, tables, dressing tables, cabinets, dressers, carpets, rugs, futons, kotatsus, sofas, ornamental figures, cupboards, beds, mattresses, etc.
Electrical appliances, machinery, etc.	Stoves, vacuum cleaners, sewing machines, audiovisual equipment, ovens, microwave ovens, speakers, etc.
Tools, conveyances, etc.	Bicycles, tricycles, skiing equipment, clothes drying poles, golf clubs, exercise equipment, baby strollers, child car seats, suitcases, etc.

Collection days	1st to 4th Thursdays of each month	Neighborhoods
Once a month	◆1st Thursday	Nishijo (except for Shiromaeda neighborhood)
	◆2nd Thursday	Hanatsune, Majima, Horinouchi, Nakajima, plus Shiromaeda neighborhood of Nishijo
	◆3rd Thursday	Sambongi, Sunago
	◆4th Thursday	Yatsuya, Nagamaki, Higashijo, Kitamajima, Kamasuka



Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law

★The five items shown below are subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law and cannot be collected by the town. For details, see the "Disposal Methods" chart on the right.



Disposal Methods

- If you no longer need the item → Ask the store where you bought the item to take it back.
- If you are buying a replacement item → Ask the store where you buy the new item to take the old item.
- Other (If you have moved and the store is now far away, if the store has gone out of business, if you received the item as a gift, etc.) → If you are not buying a replacement item, please consult the Edion store at Sennonji Az Park Shopping Center, or a comparable store.

Home personal computers

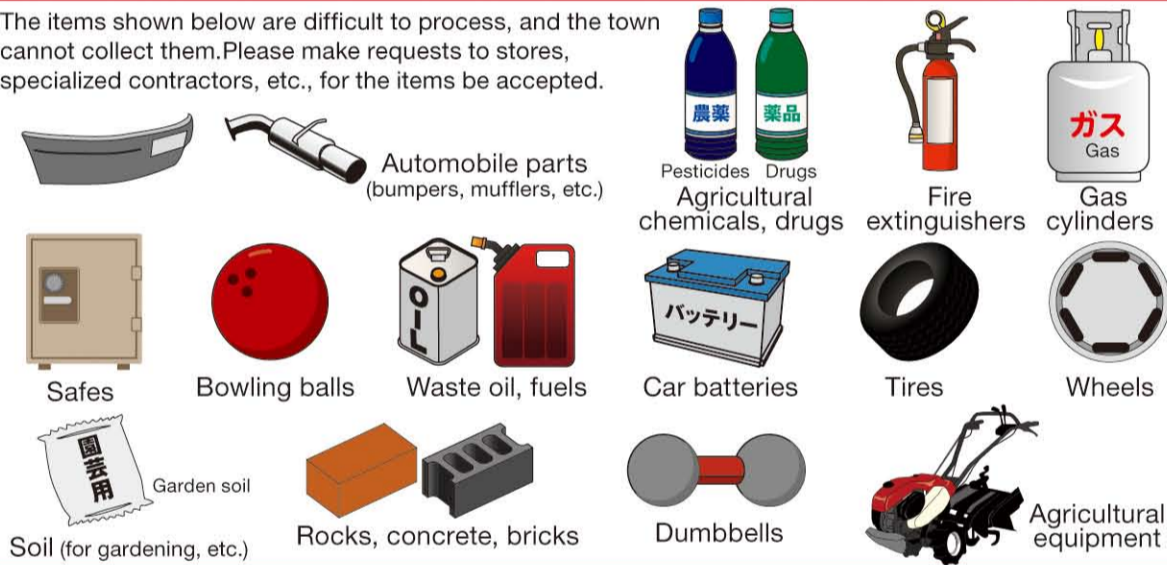
- If you no longer need the item, are buying a replacement item, have moved, etc. → Make a request to the personal computer manufacturer to collect the item.
- If there is no manufacturer, etc., to collect the item → Contact the PC 3R Promotion Association. Phone 03-5282-7685



Peripheral devices such as printers, scanners, etc., are not accepted.

Uncollectable trash (trash that cannot be put out at the collection site)

The items shown below are difficult to process, and the town cannot collect them. Please make requests to stores, specialized contractors, etc., for the items to be accepted.



You can take household trash to the processing facility yourself (for a fee).

If you want to dispose of a large amount of trash immediately, because you are preparing to move, for example, or if you want to dispose of a large item immediately, you can take the trash to the processing facility yourself in your own vehicle. If you want to take the trash to the processing facility yourself, you must first make a request to the Industrial Environment Section at the Oharu-cho town hall.

◆ Trash that will be accepted:

Combustible trash, plastic trash, incombustible trash, large refuse items that come from the home
※Trash that is generated at an office, a factory, a shop, or a store (including trash from individuals) will not be accepted.

◆ Days when trash will be accepted: Monday through Friday

◆ Hours when trash will be accepted: 8:45 a.m. to noon, 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. (must leave by 4:30 p.m.)

• Trash will not be accepted on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, and during the New Year holiday period.

• Trash will also not be accepted on days that are specified by the facility management on an ad-hoc basis.

◆ Processing site: Ama District Environmental Office Association, Hachiho Clean Center (Hachiho 399-3, Nabeta-cho, Yatomi-shi)

◆ Processing fee: 200 yen per 10 kg

◆ Procedure:

Make a request to the Industrial Environment Section. After deciding what trash to take to the facility, please make a request to the Industrial Environment Section at least 3 days prior to the day when you will go to the facility.

Receive written authorization and instructions on the day you go to the facility.

On the day you will go to the facility, load the trash into your vehicle and drive to the Industrial Environment Section. After the contents of the trash have been checked, you will be issued written authorization and instructions to take the trash to the processing facility.

Take the written authorization and instructions with you to the Clean Center.

Take the written trash processing authorization and instructions with you to the Hachiho Clean Center. Present the written authorization and instructions along with personal identification such as a driver's license, etc. After your identity has been confirmed, take the trash into the facility. After the trash has been accepted, pay the processing fee.

◆ Important Points

- The person who takes the trash to the processing facility absolutely must be the person who made the formal request. The trash will not be accepted from anyone other than the person who made the formal request.
- When a large volume of trash is taken to the processing facility in a single load, the trash must be examined before it is taken to the facility, so in some cases, the town may designate the day on which the trash will be taken to the facility.

Guide to the Recyclables Collection Station in Front of the Town Hall

Recyclables are collected at the "MOTTAINAI" recyclables collection station in front of the town hall. Be sure to take advantage of it.

◆ Operating hours:

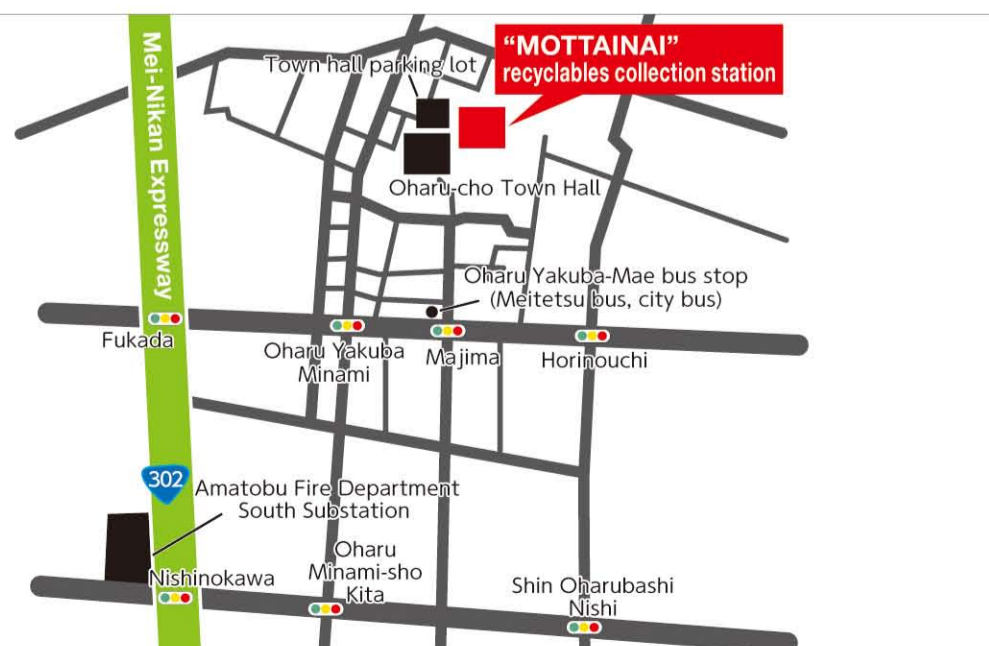
Weekdays (Monday through Friday, except for holidays), plus 2nd and 4th Saturdays (including holidays)
9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

◆ Location:

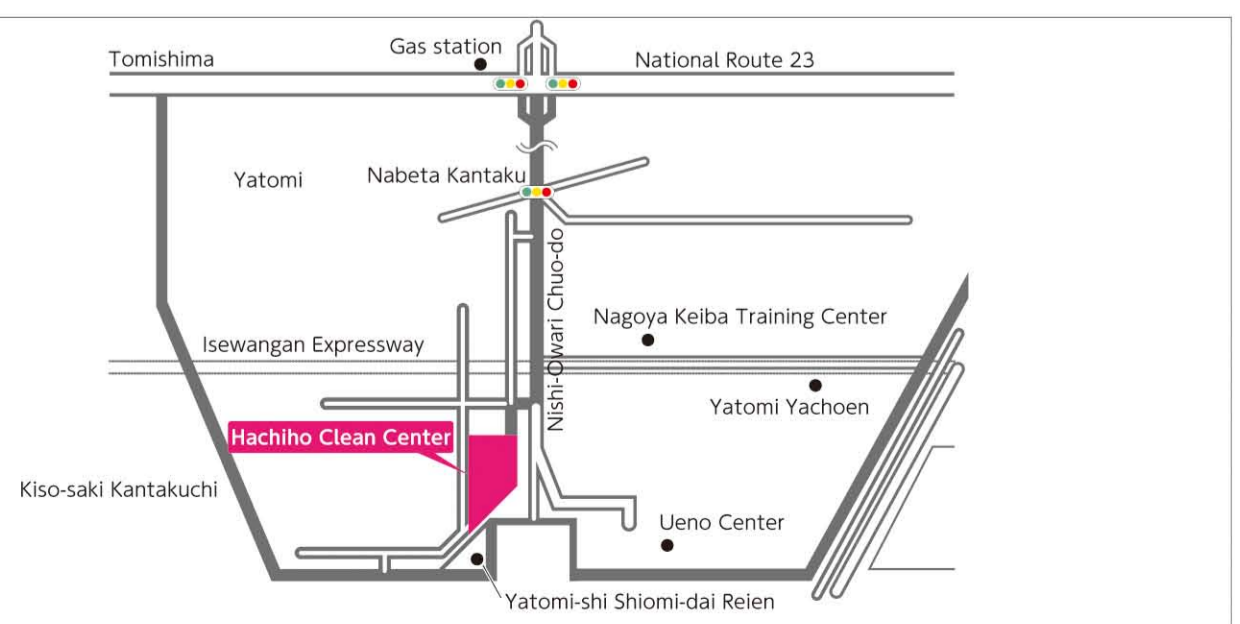
"MOTTAINAI" recyclables collection station in front of the town hall
